



Parent Information

Welcome to Kingdom Club! We're happy that your child is a part of our mid-week program! Read below for answers to many of the questions you may have about Kingdom Club. For more information, please call Gladys Gardner, Children's Ministry Director at 650/345-1633 or email: gladysg@waypoint.church.

Health

For the health of all the children and staff in our program, we ask that you do not bring your child to Kingdom Club if your child or anyone in your household has any of the following symptoms: fever of 100.4°F or higher, cough, chills, shortness of breath, difficulty breathing, fatigue, muscle or body aches, headache, new loss of taste or smell, sore throat, congestion or runny nose, nausea, vomiting, or diarrhea, contagious skin rash, or positive COVID-19 test.

Arrival

Kingdom Club begins with singing in our Sanctuary at **5:30pm - please try to have your child here on time**. Kingdom Club leaders are in the entryway of the church each week to greet children; you may drop-off your child in the loading zone in front of the church beginning at 5:15pm if you don't wish to park your car. Children should **always check-in** with the Kingdom Club leader as soon as they arrive at the church.

Dinner

Unfortunately, we are not able to serve dinner to children arriving after 5:50pm. If your child must arrive at Kingdom Club after 5:50pm we request that you serve them dinner beforehand.

If your child has food allergies (or doesn't like what's on the menu) you are welcome to send a simple dinner from home. Please **do not send food with nuts** as some children at KC have severe allergies.

Pick-up

Kingdom Club ends at 7:30pm in Geneva Hall (straight ahead as you enter the church's patio area). Children will not be allowed to leave the church without a parent or guardian. Be sure your child picks up their belongings to bring home with you. Please remember that Hacienda Street & 25th Avenue are very busy roads and it's difficult for drivers to see children, particularly after dark.
